4TH ROYAL BRUNEI POLICE FORCE EXECUTIVE DEVELOPMENT PROGRAMME FOR MIDDLE MANAGMENT OFFICERS

The Institute for Leadership, Innovation, and Advancement (ILIA), Universiti Brunei Darussalam (UBD) in collaboration with the Royal Brunei Police Force (RBPF), has launched the Executive Development Programme for Middle Management Officers (EDPMMO) 2024. This nine-week executive training programme is designed to equip 20 middle management officers with essential skills and fresh perspectives on national, global, and regional socio-political landscapes. The programme aligns with Brunei's national vision, Wawasan Brunei 2035, which aims to provide a high quality of life, education, and a sustainable economy for its citizens. Additionally, the curriculum incorporated into the programme addresses various aspects of sustainable development, reflecting Brunei's commitment to the United Nations Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs).

Key modules cover a range of topics, including Brunei's economy, which offers participants insights into the structure, economic nation's challenges, growth and opportunities. This module supports SDG 8, which promotes sustainable economic growth and productive employment. Another key module is Climate Change, which aligns with SDG 13 on Action. This module Climate provides participants with knowledge on how law enforcement can contribute to environmental sustainability and support the RBPF's role in fostering sustainable environment. Additionally, the module on Best in Police Integrity Practices Management directly supports SDG 16: Peace, Justice, and Strong Institutions, ensuring high standards of integrity within law enforcement.





As part of the programme, participants engage in a Community Outreach Programme (COP) organised by ILIA in collaboration with Malam Minggu Pusat Belia (MMPB). This initiative allows participants to actively contribute to MMPB's community engagement activities, which not only strengthens their leadership skills but also supports Brunei's sustainable development goals towards building a supportive and inclusive society.





By the end of the programme, participants are required to produce a policy analysis paper addressing key organisational, governance, and civil service challenges in Brunei Darussalam. The paper must demonstrate an integration of various learning themes, conceptual foundations principal insights and tools they have gained and learnt throughout the programme. Participants present their policy papers in the final week of the programme to receive feedback from academic experts and senior RBPF officials.

conclusion, the 4th RBPF **EDPMMO** programme not only equips participants with critical leadership skills but also fosters a new generation of leaders capable of supporting Wawasan Brunei 2035 and the United Nations Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs). Through this programme, the Royal Brunei Police Force is preparing its leaders to make a lasting, positive impact on Brunei's future.
